This lodge is named for the City of Englewood, Florida.

Englewood Lodge had seventy-five charter members and all three of the charter Line Officers came from Venice Lodge No. 301. The others came from nine Florida Lodges, two received their degrees in Englewood, U.D. and fifty out of state lodges, representing twenty-two other Grand Jurisdictions.

These nine Florida Lodges were Naval No. 24, Moore Haven No. 61, Peace River No. 66, Lakeland No. 91, Braidentown No. 99, Punta Gorda No. 115, Winter Park No. 239, Fellowship No. 265 and Venice No. 301.

The fifty out of state lodges are situated in Illinois, Michigan, New York, New Jersey, Maine, Missouri, Indiana, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Minnesota, Virginia, Georgia, Connecticut, California, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Wisconsin, District of Columbia, Wyoming, Oklahoma and Germany.
