

## PEACE RIVER LODGE NUMBER 66, F.&A.M.



Peace River Lodge No. 66 was chartered January 18, 1883 to meet at Pine Level in Manatee County.

The three Line Officers at chartering were:

James D. Haygood — Worshipful Master  
Nathan C. Platt — Senior Warden  
William J. Allbritton — Junior Warden

The chartering Grand Lodge Officers were:

William E. Anderson — Grand Master  
Robert J. Perry — Deputy Grand Master  
Marcus Endel — Senior Grand Warden  
Norvelle R. Carter — Junior Grand Warden  
DeWitt C. Dawkins — Grand Secretary

Lodge was originally chartered as Pine Level Lodge No. 66 and met at Pine Level in Manatee County.

Number 66 was first used by LaFayette Lodge No. 66, February 13, 1873, which met at Old Town, in LaFayette County. This lodge surrendered their charter in 1880. Pine Level Lodge received this number January 18, 1883 to meet at Pine Level, in Manatee County. This lodge moved to Arcadia and changed its name to Peace River, in 1895. Peace River is still an active lodge.

Charter surrendered July 29, 1927.

Charter restored August 31, 1927.

The history of the charter members is part of the history shown for Pine Level Lodge No. 66.
